Bava Metzia ("The Middle Gate") is one of the first volumes traditionally studied by newcomers to the Talmud, since it contains so many of the basic elements common to all Talmudic logic. It focuses on the resolution of disputes that may arise in daily life and commercial transactions, such as rival claims to the ownership of property. **Chapter four of Bava Metzia deals with laws relating to title, real and personal; fraud, what constitutes fraud and the circumstances surrounding fraudulent transactions.**
